Written in English, Spanish, and Taino, this drama tells the story of a mountain tobacco community in the 1940s and the adventures they face as they leave the mountains of Puerto Rico in search of a better life. Featuring the poetry of Julia de Burgos, this drama will inspire you to consider your own journey.

DIRECTIONS TO THEATER: The George Washington Carver Museum and Cultural Center is located east of downtown Austin at the corner of Rosewood Ave and Angelina St. From I-35, take 11th St East. Follow the road as it forks to the left and becomes Rosewood Ave. Follow Rosewood Ave two blocks to Angelina St.

Our 13th original production, Mi Tierra Boricua, was written by Tekina-eiru Maynard with the support of community elders in Puerto Rico including Jesus Reyes and others from Tekina-eiru's pueblo Taino who shared oral history and memories of the mountains of Boriken from days gone by.
